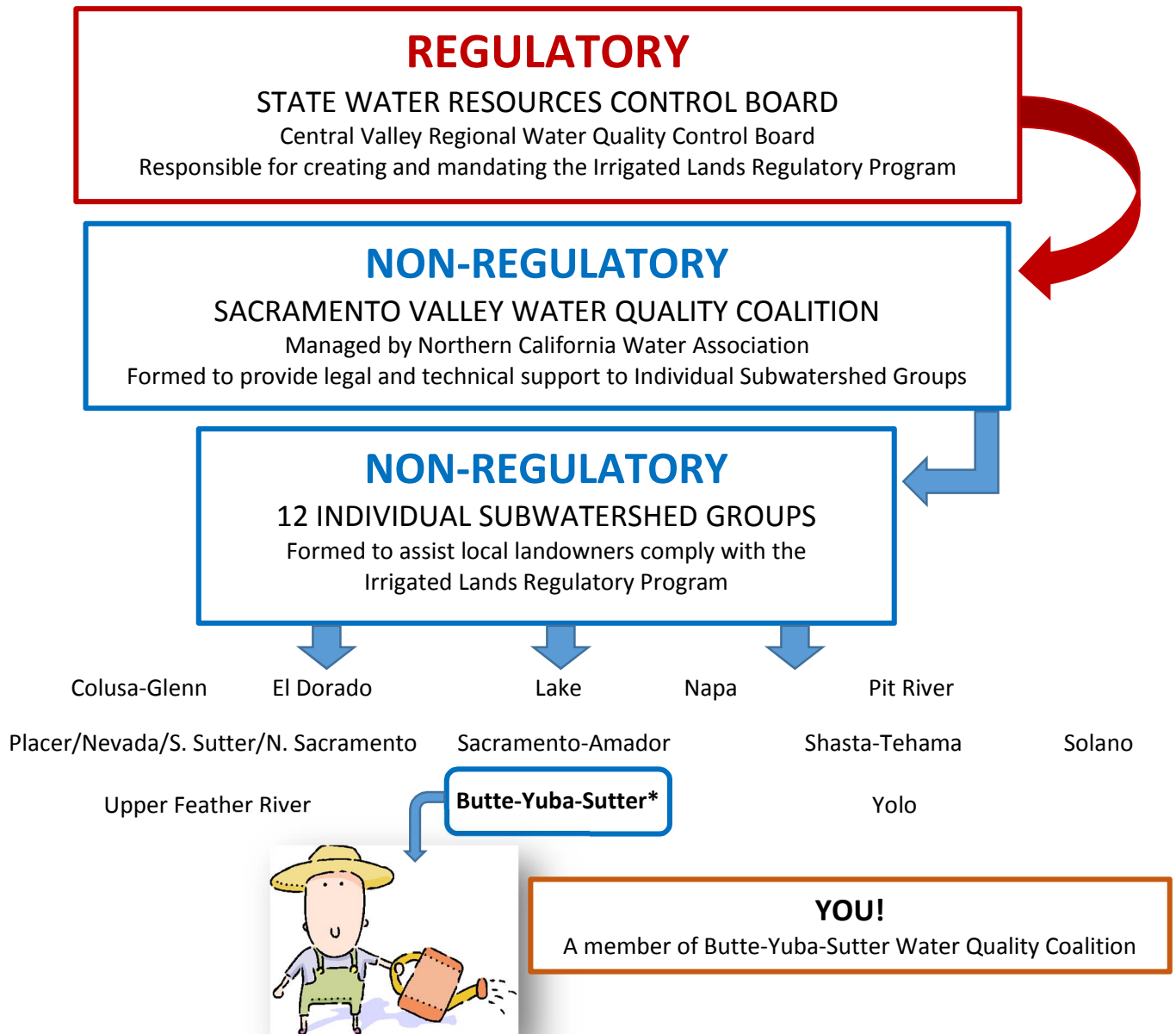


BUTTE-YUBA-SUTTER WATER QUALITY COALITION - WHO WE ARE

If you are a member of the Butte-Yuba-Sutter Water Quality Coalition, you may still be scratching your head trying to figure out who the regulators of the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program (Program) are, and who the folks are that are trying to help you comply with the Program. We hope this diagram, and the explanations below will help dissect the pieces.



*The Butte-Yuba-Sutter Water Quality Coalition (BYSWQC) was formed in 2004 to provide a local, grass-roots, non-governmental entity specifically for the purpose of assisting local landowners of irrigated, commercial agriculture comply with the state-mandated Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program. BYSWQC has a nine member board of trustees - 3 trustees from each county. To manage the operations required of BYSWQC, 3 organizations hold contracts to provide those services. The Yuba-Sutter Farm Bureau manages the membership database and is responsible for enrolling members, invoicing and providing input from BYSWQC. The outreach and education component of BYSWQC is managed as follows. Butte County Farm Bureau serves Butte County growers. Sutter County Resource Conservation District serves Yuba & Sutter Counties.
